Week 1 July 26 Titus 1:1-4

Our goal and purpose is to see our faith grow in Jesus through His Word

Hi everybody. This is our first week of being in church with our families. We will sing together, pray to our Heavenly Father and hear God's Word read to us.

During the adult talk you are most welcome to listen while you take time to complete one or more of the activities included. You can do this during the adult talk or throughout your 'Sabbath Day'; which we set apart to worship Jesus.

With your HEAD, HEARTS and HANDS, chat with your family and ask:

1. What you THINK the Bible is saying to you (HEAD)
2. What you FEEL about what God was saying in the talk (HEART)
3. How shall we LIVE and ACT now that we have heard from God's Word (HANDS)

Here is the Bible reading for today but in language we can understand for the CEV Bible reading from Titus 1:1-4

Paul is writing this letter to Titus who is also a Christian...

'I encourage God's own people to have more faith and to understand the truth about religion. Then they will have the hope of eternal life that God promised long ago. And God never tells a lie! So, at the proper time, God our Saviour gave this message and told me to announce what he had said. Titus, because of our faith, you are like a son to me. I pray that God our Father and Christ Jesus our Saviour will be kind to you and will bless you with peace!'


We have read from Titus chapter 1 sentences 1-4 and have seen that our goal and purpose is to see our faith grow in Jesus through His Word

Have fun making and playing 'flick football' during the adult talk. As you play, remember that our goal in life is to grow our faith in Jesus through His Word

Flick football needs 2 people to play. You score a touchdown by sliding a small folded triangle of paper (the "ball") to opposite edges of a table so it hangs off without falling. After a touchdown, the scorer gets a chance to flick the "ball" through a field goal the opponent makes with his or her fingers. All you need is the ball so here are the instructions:



1. Grab an A4 sheet of paper.
2. Fold the paper in half lengthwise. You have a long skinny rectangle.
3. Rip or cut the paper along the fold. You now have two strips about 10cm wide. Put one strip aside.
4. Fold one strip of paper in half lengthwise. You have a strip about 5cm wide. Crease every fold in this project firmly for a thin football, or lightly for a puffy one.
5. Fold the top right corner of the strip down toward the left edge, forming a triangle.
6. Fold the top point of the triangle down along the left edge, over the previous fold, so you again have a triangle.
7. Fold the top left corner of the strip (which should also be the top left corner of your triangle) down across to the right edge of the paper. You again have a triangle.
8. Fold the top point of the triangle down along the right edge over the previous fold. You still have a triangle.
9. Repeat steps 5 through 7 and you should reach the end of the paper strip.
10. Tuck the extra paper into the "pocket" created from your folding.
11. Repeat steps 4 through 9 to make a backup football for when you lose the first football.
12. Play ball!







